

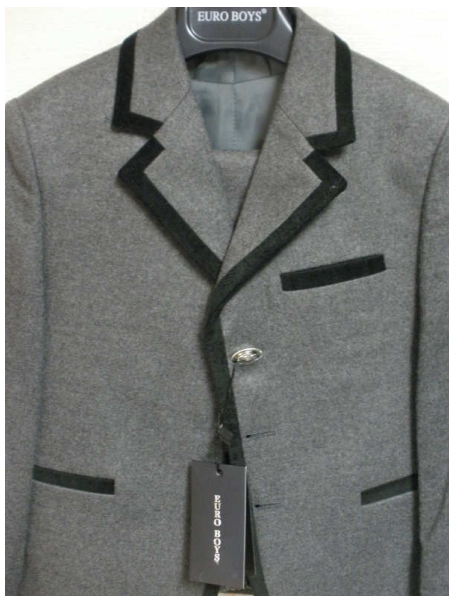

Frequently asked Question:

My garment does not list wool or linen. Does it require testing for shatnez?

Answer:

The content label refers to the outer shell fabric only. The composition of the inner components is not listed. Wool and linen can be found in the inner components.

Recent Example:

A “Euro Boys” boy’s suit contents label listed 67% Polyester, 33%

Viscose. However wool and linen were found in the inner components. See picture.

These suits were manufactured in Turkey for a Jewish company.
