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The Educated Consumer



Pictured above is a tag that was attached to the sleeve of an **Adolfo International** men's tan, linen-look jacket. All that was visible on the tag was **60% Wool**. No other contents label was attached to the suit.

A sticker, as seen in the picture above, covered the portion of the contents that read 40% Linen. This jacket was brought to the Kehilla Shatnez Laboratory (Los Angeles) for shatnez testing.

The lesson is: An educated consumer who is aware that a linen-look fabric is characterized by any irregularity in yarn, weave or color will suspect that such a garment may well be Shatnez.
