Have there been any issues with a 100% Bruno Piattelli Lambs wool scarf from China having any Shatnez?

**Answer:** No issues have been found regarding this particular scarf, however the type of scarves that would require testing are as follows:

- A. Knit scarves
- B. Scarves that list other fibers in their content label
- C. Scarves that have a linen look

Linen look can be recognized by having one of the following characteristics:

- A. Yarns of uneven thickness
- B. Little balls or fluffs scattered throughout the fabric
