Fox's Lady's Jacket



Garments made of linen-look fabric should be checked for shatnez. This is because such a fabric may contain wool and linen and be intrinsically shatnez. The disclosure of wool and linen may be missing on the content label of such a fabric. A garment that has little balls (i.e. slubs) throughout the fabric is categorized as a linen-look fabric.

The above picture shows a Lady's Jacket that was purchased at Fox's. Little balls (i.e. slubs) are scattered throughout the fabric. Its content label listed 35% Wool, 40% Polyester, 25% Viscose. The fabric also contained linen, which was not listed on the label.
