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## Linen Scraps in Children's Coats



Linen

Shatnez was discovered in a child's wool-blend winter coat. This coat is currently sold in a store called **The Children's Place**.

**Brand Name:** Place [Finest Quality Outerwear Ltd. Edition No 915]

**The contents label lists:** 57% Polyester 40% Wool 3% Other Fibers

**Country of Origin:** China

**Shatnez:** A bridge is a scrap of material that is used to connect two components. The bridge connecting the fabric lining to the outer shell in this coat was linen (see picture).

**The lesson is:** Though this coat does not have shoulder pads it still had shatnez. This explains why all, wool articles of clothing should be checked for shatnez.

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
